Annual licenses are also available **online ONLY** for \$70. For non-licensed riders it is highly suggested that you purchase an annual license at <http://www.usacycling.org> and bring an Authorization to Ride with you if you haven't received the license yet. Categories will be combined or split at promoter's discretion based on attendance. Promoter reserves the right to cancel races that do not meet the minimum field limit listed above or merge fields to achieve minimum field sizes.

No extra charge for multiple categories. Rider sign-in opens 1½ hours before racing begins and closes 15 minutes before racing begins. **Pre-registration is REQUIRED and can be done on <http://www.bikereg.com> until Saturday, May 13<sup>th</sup>.** Pre-registrations by mail will be accepted if received by Monday, May 8<sup>th</sup>. Please include USAC Standard Entry Form and check payable to Atwood Racing Services and send to Alan Atwood, 62 Timber Ridge Dr, Holbrook, NY 11741. **Riders under 18 years of age must have parent or legal guardian present to sign race waiver.** It is highly suggested that junior riders fill out a waiver form and have their parent/legal guardian sign in before traveling to the track.

### Qualifications for Features:

- A Feature: Top 5 omnium in Men 1/2/3, Top 3 in Men 4, Winner of Masters 50+, and Women 1/2/3.
- B Feature: Remaining omnium placers in Men 1/2/3, Places 2-4 in Women 1/2/3, Places 4-10 in Men 4, Top 3 in Men 5 & Juniors 9-14, Places 2-5 in Masters 50+, Top 3 of Women 3/4/5.
- C Feature: Remaining omnium placers in Men 4, Women 1/2/3, Women 3/4/5, and Masters 50+, Places 4-10 in Men 5 and Junior 9-14.
- These qualifications are subject to change based on attendance and to achieve a field size of at least 10 for each feature.

## 2017 KISSENA VELODROME SPRING CLASSIC

### Explanation of races

#### Omnium

- The top 5 riders in each event will receive 7, 5, 3, 2, and 1 point.
- Riders who are disqualified from an event cannot receive omnium points for that event and the riders next in the standings will move up and earn the higher amount of points.
- A rider who is disqualified from more than 1 race will not be eligible for the overall omnium.
- Ties in overall omnium points will be broken by # of first place finishes, # of 2<sup>nd</sup> place finishes, and then placing in the last race that either of the riders participated in.

#### Scratch Race

- 1<sup>st</sup> rider to the line in the prescribed amount of laps wins.
- Top 5 will receive omnium points.

#### Points Race

- Top 4 in each sprint will receive 5, 3, 2, and 1 point.
- No double points on final sprints
- Riders who lap the main field will receive 20 points. Riders who get lapped by the main field will lose 20 points.
- Rider with the most points wins the race. Ties in points will be broken by placing in final sprint.

#### Win & Out

- The race will be 9 laps in length and have 3 sprints.
- Whoever wins the first sprint at 6 to go is the winner and shall retire from the race.
- Whoever wins the second sprint at 3 to go is the 2<sup>nd</sup> place rider and also shall retire from the race.
- The remaining field will sprint for the 3 remaining omnium places at the end of the race.

#### Miss & Out/Elimination

- Race begins with one neutral lap.
- Afterwards the last rider in the field will be asked to withdraw from the race. Riders determined to be dropped from the main field will automatically be withdrawn from the race.
- **Miss & Out:** Depending on the size of the field at the start, riders will be removed until at least 3 but no more than 5 remain. The finalists will have one neutral lap and then will sprint for places.
- **Elimination:** Riders will be removed until 2 remain. The next lap will determine the winner of the race.

#### Chariot

- The race will be 1 lap in length.
- Riders will be held at the start/finish line. At start, holders may push but must not cross the finish line.
- 1<sup>st</sup> across the finish line after 1 lap wins.
- If there are more than 8 riders in the field, heats will be held with no less than 6 but no more than 8 riders advancing to the final.



## 2017 KISSENA VELODROME SPRING CLASSIC

### Explanation of races

#### Tempo/Super Tempo

- Each lap, top riders earn points.
- Tempo: The first 2 riders earn 2 and 1 points respectively
- Super Tempo: The first 3 riders earn 3, 2, and 1 points respectively
- Points are added up and the rider with the highest point total wins.
- Tiebreaker is the order of finish of the last lap.

#### Snowball

- Each lap, the lead rider earns points.
- The points increase each lap
  - Winner of the 1<sup>st</sup> lap earns 1 point
  - Winner of the 2<sup>nd</sup> lap earns 2 points
  - Winner of the 3<sup>rd</sup> lap earns 3 points.....
- Points are added up and the rider with the highest point total wins.
- Tiebreaker is the order of finish of the last lap.

#### Win & Out

- 9 lap race with sprints every 3 laps
  - Winner of the sprint at 6 to go is 1<sup>st</sup> place in the race and may retire.
  - Winner of the sprint at 3 to go is 2<sup>nd</sup> place the race and may retire.
  - Final sprint will determine 3<sup>rd</sup>, 4<sup>th</sup>, and 5<sup>th</sup> in the race.

#### Devil's Scratch

- # of laps based on # of participants
- 1st half of the race is run as an elimination
- 2nd half of the race is run as a scratch race
- Announcement will be made on the line as to # of riders to be pulled and what lap to go when the pulling stops and the scratch race begins.
